

Rules To Teachers

This event is for all-level students to encourage the study of piano and to motivate them for future performance. Therefore, the participating teachers must be available the day of Musical Passport Festival.

【Performance Hours】

- We host the entire event between 9am and 12pm in the morning time. If there are too many participants, we extend the event from 12pm into the afternoon.

【Format: In-person or Online】

- Online Youtube Link deadline is October 29th, 2022
- Students must include both pieces in one recording. Submit only one Youtube link to the chair. Submissions with two links will not be accepted.

【Volunteer Hours】

- The teachers whose students are participating are expected to contribute volunteer hours for activities such as judging other students.
- The time will be based on how many students the teacher is entering.
- When there are online participants, we will have an online evaluation assigned to the chosen teacher(s), depending on the condition.

【Registration Fee (Due by 10/22/2022)】

- Each teacher must calculate the total fee for their studio and then send ONE check, payable to LWMTA (non-refundable) to Pei-Hsin. In the Fall 2022. We increase \$5 for each category this time. Payment via Zelle or Chase is available

【Grading system】

- Gold is considered “passing.”
- A teacher is not allowed to grade their own students.
- When grading other students, consider the goal for this event; to encourage and motivate students in all levels. Be generous and fair on grading.
- When writing comments, simple sentences or bullet points are recommended. Write at least one positive and one thing to be improved.

【Medal and Trophies】

- In the 2nd year of “passing”, the student will receive a medal.

- 4th year will be a small trophy, 6th year will be a bigger trophy.
- A certificate is given to all students participating.
