Registration

Music and Levels

Please only use music sheets obtained from legal sources. Online participants must scan the music and send it to the chair by the submission deadline (October 28th, 2023). It is encouraged to perform by memory. Performing with music is permitted but will decrease the rating by one level.

Performances

Students must perform two memorized pieces (or more for Primary Level) of music each from different eras. Eras to be considered include Baroque, Classical, Romantic/Post-Romantic/Contemporary. For Primary levels, choose contrasting style pieces.

Online Participation

Students must <u>record both pieces in one video and submit only ONE YouTube link</u> to the chair by October 28, 2023. Submission with two separate recordings or links will not be accepted.

It is recommended to perform on either a tuned piano or 88-key weighted keyboard. Students may finish their performance with a bow at the end. Be sure to include the performer's whole upper body including their face and hands in a recording.

Grading Criteria

The Performance as written in the score is what is evaluated. Missing a few notes does not automatically lower the grading. Performance with music lowers the rating by one level.

Online performance is evaluated more strictly than in-person performance.

Diamond	An exceptional performance. Convincing, impressive as mature performance.
Gold	Good performance with memory following most of the indications in music.
Silver	Fair performance with several improvements needed.
Bronze	Participation in the event.

Rewards

Students who achieve Gold level or above will be eligible for incentives, starting from the second year of participation. A certificate is given to all participants.
