Each teacher must calculate the total fee for their studio and send one payment (check payable to LWMTA) Electronic payment (Zelle or Venmo) is available – please contact the chair for the payment details. The registration fee is NON-REFUNDABLE.
ONLINE PARTICIPATION	 Students must record both pieces in ONE VIDEO and submit ONE YouTube Link (private link) to the chair. It is recommended to perform on either a tuned piano or 88-key weighted keyboard. Be sure to include the performer's whole upper body including their face and hands in a recording. Submission of 2 separate recordings will not be accepted.
GRADING SYSTEM	 Gold is considered "passing." A teacher is not allowed to grade their own students. When grading a student, consider the goal for this event; to encourage and motivate students at all levels. Be generous and fair on grading. Comments must include at least one positive and one thing to be improved. Simple sentences or bullet points are recommended. Be specific in your comment.
REWARDS	 Students who achieve Gold rating or above will be eligible for incentives, starting from the second year of participation: 2nd year – medal 4th year – small trophy 6th year – larger trophy When given two different ratings, a higher rating will be recorded. A certificate is given to all participating students.
