Registration

Music and Levels

Participants must use music sheets obtained from legal sources only. Online performers must scan the music and send it to the chair by the submission deadline (November 8th, 2025). It is encouraged to perform by memory.

Park (Primary)	5 fingers	\$35	2 min

Performances

Students must perform two memorized pieces (or more for Primary Level) of music each from different eras. For Primary levels, choose contrasting style pieces.

Eras to be considered include Baroque, Classical, Romantic/Post-Romantic/Contemporary.

Popular selections piece is permitted but is suggested to be paired with a piece from Baroque or Classical eras.

Online Participation

Students must record both pieces in one video and submit only ONE YouTube link to the chair by the online submission deadline. Submission with two separate recordings or links will not be accepted.

It is recommended to perform on either a tuned piano or 88-key weighted keyboard. Students may finish their performance with a bow at the end. Be sure to include the performer's whole upper body including their face and hands in a recording.

Evaluation Criteria

The Performance as written in the score is what is evaluated. Minor note errors do not automatically impact the overall rating. Performing with music is permitted but may result in a one-level deduction from the final rating. If judges assign two different ratings, the higher rating will be used to determine the reward.

Diamond	An exceptional performance. Convincing, impressive as mature performance.
Gold	Good performance with memory following most of the indications in music.
Silver	Fair performance with several improvements needed.
Bronze	Participation in the event.

Rewards

Students who achieve Gold level or above will be eligible for incentives, starting from the second year of participation. A certificate is given to all participants.
